FEDERAL WITHDRAWAL REGULATIONS FOR LATE-STARTING CLASSES

If you do not remain enrolled in classes that have not yet started, the Financial Aid Office is required to calculate how much aid a student needs to return. By submitting the "Intent to Attend Confirmation" form we can confirm if you still qualify for all or part of your financial aid for the current semester.

What does this mean?

If you do not confirm your intent to attend late-start classes for which you have registered this semester, but have not started, and you have not completed 61 percent of the semester, we are required to calculate how much financial aid you have earned. The college would have to return a portion to the government. The student would owe a balance due to the College.

What do I need to do?

Complete and submit this form to the financial aid office confirming your intent to stay enrolled in classes that have not started for this semester. If you do not plan to stay enrolled in the late-starting classes listed below, please withdraw.
