Job Seeker Highlight: Ferris




Ferris—a shining example of one of Network2Work@PVCC's **Job Seekers**—has been employed at Pepsi-Cola since Nov. 11, 2019.

and Providers. He is currently working on a moving up to a new job position. Good luck, Ferris!






Provider Organization Highlight:
The Fountain Fund



The Fountain Fund provides low-interest loans to formerly incarcerated people. Since lending commenced in 2017, they have provided nearly 150 loans totaling over a half million dollars. To be eligible for a loan someone must be formerly incarcerated, have the ability to pay back the loan, and be able to say how the loan will elevate their life. Through a partnership with Operation Hope, the Fountain Fund also offers 1:1 financial wellness coaching. Learn more about the Fountain Fund here.


